### **Chemoil prepared for Europe's stricter emissions regulations**

SINGAPORE: Marine fuels supplier Chemoil said Friday that it is prepared for stricter emissions regulations in Europe.

From July this year, ships operating in European Emissions Controls Areas will be required to have a sulphur content not exceeding one per cent.

That's lower than the current requirement of 1.5 per cent.

Chemoil says it is well prepared to meet demand for lower sulphur oxide bunker fuel to vessels in the Ports of Antwerp and Rotterdam in anticipation of the new rules.

Antwerp and Rotterdam are the key bunker ports in North West Europe.

Chemoil is one the largest suppliers of low sulfur bunker fuel in the Amsterdam-Rotterdam-Antwerp bunkering hub.

It says it has been actively working with its customers using the ports to address any concerns about fuel availability and pricing due to the new regulation.

The firm adds that it will continue to monitor the supply situation in terms of volume demand. -
