Singapore lists bunkers suppliers by volume for 2010

BP Singapore has remained Singapore's biggest bunker supplier by volume in 2010 for the seventh year running while ExxonMobil retained second position, data from the local port authority showed Tuesday.

The list, compiled by the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA), ranked SK Energy International at third place last year, unchanged from its 2009 position.

Industry estimates have put average sales for the top three players at 250,000-300,000 metric tonnes (mt) per month, with more during peak periods.

The MPA listed Singapore's accredited bunker suppliers by volume in 2010, but did not reveal sales figures for each company due to commercial sensitivities.

Aegean Bunkering, which saw its standings improved to fourth place last year from seventh in 2009, have said it experienced "significant sales volume growth" in Singapore and Fujairah during the third quarter (Q3).

Chemoil International, rose to sixth from ninth position this year. The company earlier said that its volumes in Singapore had risen to between 250,000-400,000 mt per month last year.

Local companies, Sentek Marine & Trading and Searights Marine Services, were at seventh and tenth positions respectively.

Sources say average volumes moved by suppliers from seventh to the tenth positions were between 100,000-170,000 mt per month last year.

New entrants Universal Energy was ranked at the 26th position while Southernpec (Singapore) took the 32nd spot, Vermont UM Bunkering at the 40th position and Noble Resources was ranked at 46th place.

The companies received their accredited licenses last year, bringing the total number of accredited suppliers in Singapore to 80.

Singapore reported record bunker sales of 40.9 million mt in 2010, up 12.3% from the 36.4 million mt sold in 2009.
